CALL FOR PAPERS

The annual meeting of the Association for Institutional Thought and Western Social Science Association will be held in Portland, Oregon, April 25-28, 1990. If you wish to organize a session, author a paper, or serve as a discussant or moderator, inform me by December 1, 1989.

Paper proposals in any area of institutional inquiry will be given serious consideration. Recent graduates and current graduate students are especially encouraged to submit quality proposals.

To build on the contributions of graduate students at recent AFIT meetings, the Board has established a graduate student paper competition. To compete, graduate students will submit (finished) papers to a committee chaired by Professor James Dietz. Authors of outstanding papers will receive a cash award and will be encouraged to present their paper(s) at the AFIT meeting. Details, including guidelines and deadline for submitting a paper for this competition are forthcoming from Dietz's committee.

PLEASE NOTE: Students who respond to this call for papers are not required to enter the paper competition, although they are encouraged to do so.

As in recent years, conference preregistration will be required. Please submit a paper proposal only if you are confident you will finish your paper in a timely manner and attend the meeting.

All paper proposals must include your name, affiliation, address, phone, paper title, and a one-page abstract.
